

International Society for River Science hosting





This is a major international conference on river science being organised by the University of Waikato providing an opportunity to showcase the vision and strategy for the Waikato River.

Hamilton will be hosting the 2017 conference of the International Society for River Science (ISRS) with the theme of "Integrating multiple values", attracting scientists and river managers from a range of countries. The ISRS conference will be held in parallel with the New Zealand Freshwater Sciences Society conference, with an expected combined attendance of around 400 delegates (anticipating 150 from ISRS). A range of plenary speakers, special sessions, field excursions, and public engagement are planned with a focus on the Waikato River, providing the Waikato River Authority with an opportunity to showcase its work to an international forum.
