

This project aims to restore the riparian margins of the lower reaches of the Karapiro Stream

The Karapiro Stream and gully is integral to the well-being of Te Awa O Waikato. The Karapiro stream catchment is erosion prone and carries a large volume of silt. Run off and flooding scours the bank, threatening planting and vegetation. Erosion causing sedimentation, nutrient loss from farmland to waterways and loss of biodiversity within the catchment are primary issues of concern.

This project aims to work towards a healthier gully system through on going planting, bank stabilisation and weed clearing.
