

Mangaonua Stream Gully restoration





The projects involves improving the Waikato River water quality through the establishment of native plants on the Mangaonua Gully System which will filter the water as it enters the waterway and minimize subsidence in the gully.

The project will include the clearance and maintenance control of pest plants and obnoxious weeds in a sustainable manner in order to protect the biodiversity of the whenua and water quality.

Our aim throughout this project is to have minimal or no spraying when we undertake this work. We wll endevour to prepare for the new plantings and develop and maintain walkway paths with minimal impact on the eco-system within the gully.
