Restore and protect the health and wellbeing of the Mangaonua catchment.


The project's primary objective is to restore and protect the health and wellbeing of the Mangaonua catchment, a tributary to the Waikato River.

The Mangaonua Stream waterway system is significant to Ngāti Hauā. The proposed workable site consists of 3 wetland systems totalling 6.02ha that is completely covered in gorse. The wetland systems are situated on a dairy support block (Pukemoremore K) which filters into the Mangaonua catchment.

Project includes: site preparation, fencing, planting and maintenance, montioring, infill planting, community planting days and cultural learning.

This project received funding from the Waikato River Authority (WRA 16-009).
