

Mangaotama Wetland Restoration

The Mangaotama Wetland Restoration project aims to restore a 30 hectare wetland near Ngahinepouri.

Mangaotama wetland encompasses a 2.5km stretch of Mangaotama Stream and an adjoining gully system (with fingers extending into the Staarvon Farms property) and is approximately 30ha in size. The objective of this project is to restore the wetland and associated gully systems to a healthy, native plant dominated ecosystem that will provide habitat for indigenous birds, bats, fish and invertebrates, as well as filtering out sediments, nutrients and pathogens from surrounding land.
