This project involves the physical restoration and planting of three sites. One near the Huntly water treatment plant on the Waikato River and the other two on the Mangawara Stream.

This project involves the physical restoration and planting of three sites, one project is located on the main stem of the Waikato River just downstream of the Huntly community water treatment plant and the other two projects are located on the banks of the Mangawara Stream. The two Mangawara Stream projects are significantly different from the main stem Waikato River project in that high value indigenous forest remnants are located within the project scope. The main stem Waikato River project is an extension of the highly successful Raahui Pookeka A project completed in 2013 with WRA funding which is located just up-stream of the community water treatment plant.
