
To restore an area of the Waikato River, located near Cambridge Primary

Nature of the project is to turn the overgrown unusable area behind the school fence, down to the walkway by the Waikato River, into a safe native area for the students and local community.

We are converting an overgrown and unusable piece of land into a replanted native area with a flat grass area for the students to use as an Outdoor Classroom conversation area / play area.

There is also be a path from the school linking up to the flat grass area (which will have seating and / or picnic tables) and then continuing on to connect to the current walkway (from under the Victoria Bridge) available for community use.
