To establish stream bank and flood stabilisation on Hamilton streams

Some Hamilton City Council parks within Hamilton city have major tributaries that link to the Waikato River. These streams flood in heavy rain and the banks are seriously affected by excess water that flows down them.

The 2012 works will consist of stream bank and flood stabilisation with planting and infill climax planting of the existing restoration sites. The areas considered are sites that have high value in regards to natural water treatment and sites with recent erosion problems highlighted in Management Plans for the Major Streams and the Waikato River.

The plantings of these sites will be designed for maximum benefit for the major streams and the Waikato River. These works will be completed between April 2012 and April 2013
