A Waikato Regional Council project to develop a 20 year Waipa Catchment Plan


The aim of this project is to develop a 20 year Waipa Catchment Plan and commence its implementation.

The Waipa Catchment Plan will provide a roadmap for the protection and restoration of the health and well being of the Waipa and in turn the Waikato River. This will be achieved by working with Maniapoto Maori Trust Board, Waikato-Raupatu River Trust, Raukawa Charitable Trust and other key partners to develop an integrated plan for works in the Waipa River Catchment.

A major component of this project is to produce a Waipa Risk Map that will further refine the issues identified in the Waikato River Independent Scoping Study specific to the Waipa catchment. It will provide clear direction on the key issues including their priority, scale and location. It will also provide guidance on remediation actions, scale of those actions and measurable targets to achieve the Waikato River Authority Vision.

Waipa Risk Map will be valuable for all agencies and stakeholders working in the catchment and in particular the Waikato River Authority (WRA) in its role in administering the cleanup fund.
