MEMORANDUM OF COUNSEL FOR BEEF+LAMB NEW ZEALAND LIMITED ATTACHING HS2 PROPOSED PLAN PROVISIONS 27 June 2019

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MAY IT PLEASE THE COMMISSIONERS:

- Yesterday, (24 June 2019) Counsel filed legal submissions in respect of B+LNZ's case for HS2. Those submissions indicated that amended plan provisions, updating Appendix 1 to Ms Jordan's evidence, would be filed.
- 2. The amended proposed plan provisions have now been finalised and are attached to this memorandum as Appendix 1.
- 3. These proposed provisions replace those attached to Ms Jordan's 9 May 2019 evidence. They do not greatly change the provisions filed with Ms Jordan's evidence (changes are marked with a yellow highlight), but the drafting of the provisions has benefited from further review and reflection.
- 4. It is these provisions that will be addressed by Counsel and Ms Jordan at the hearing.
- Counsel also attaches for filing a brief of evidence of the Chief Executive of B+LNZ, Mr McIvor. Mr McIvor is a lay witness and gave evidence as part of B+LNZ's HS1 case.
- 6. Mr McIvor's HS2 evidence addresses the ongoing work being undertaken to provide for the resilience of the sector. It is largely factual and explains B+LNZ's, as an organisation, position. Amongst other things, it also sets out the principles that B+LNZ have adopted for allocation, which have previously been referred to by other witnesses.
- 7. B+LNZ regrets and apologises for the delay in filing this evidence.
