




The Adaptive Management Cycle



The phases that make up the recurring resilience adaptive cycle; release, reorganisation, exploitation, and conservation. The cycle represents a heuristic model where the system response and learns from the responses, leading to learning and improvement.

Changes in ecosystem processes & unintended consequences of earlier policy



Conceptual alterations to the hydrology of altered catchments. A and B represent catchment water storage capacity in hill country; C represents flood plain storage and D represents estuary or harbour.

This figure was developed by Ellis et al. (2018) to represent hydraulic changes in Murihiku/Southland catchments.
