The decision I would like the council to make regarding this provision is:

I would like the council to make changes to "social disruption" should be simplified or specified in terms of what part of social arena or what exact events or activities are to be minimised. If not, then, please separate "social disruption" and "enables innovation and new practices". (if need be)

I think that it is best to separate these two texts in a more understanding way. For example: Recognise that achieving the water quality attribute^ targets^ set out in Table 11-1 will need to be staged over 80 years. The following approaches/needs are to be staged as listed below:

- a. minimise social disruption
- b. enable innovation
- c. develop new practices
- d. start on reducing discharges of nitrogen, phosphorus, sediment and microbial pathogens
- e. Preparing for further reductions...

The reason for requesting this decision is:

I would like the council to consider what it means "to minimise social disruption". It seems to me that the target is to minimise social disruption, which could mean social change or social activities that will disrupt the plans and targets set out. In my opinion, it is not specifically portraying a direct meaning as to what social factors is disrupting. Also, I am confused as to how these texts "to minimise social disruption" and "enable innovation and new practices to develop" correlates with each other in terms of putting them together. I somewhat agree with these texts. But I am trying to figure out how "minimising social disruption" can connect perfectly with "enables innovation and new practices". The moment I read these text, it sort of confuses me because social disruption could mean many things like social change or change in societal views, which can be disrupting but also it can be good for the betterment of the country at some levels. I think that if "social disruption" should be simplified or specified in terms of what part of social arena or what exact events or activities are to be minimised, then the whole text could be clearer. Otherwise, I think that it is best to separate these two texts in a more clearer way.
