Eligibility criteria:

- · you own and reside in the property
- · you receive the DIA rebate from your city or district council
- · your property is classified as residential by Waikato Regional Council*
- your property is owned by individual(s) (not trusts, companies or similar ownership structures)
- you have received no penalties to any outstanding account balance with Waikato Regional Council.

The remission will be up to 15 per cent of the average Waikato Regional Council rates assessed on residential rating units, as defined within District Valuation Roll (DVR) for the current financial year.
